## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Test Kit Distribution**

Throughout the months of September and October, the Cayuga County Health Department distributed rapid COVID-19 antigen tests to several community partners. The tests that were distributed are the iHealth Rapid Antigen brand; they are packaged in a box of two tests per box and expire in January of 2023. The Federal Drug Administration (FDA) has extended the expiration dates of these at-home test kits, which has been updated on each box.
