

Town of Victory Highway Department Mailbox Recommendations

The only recommended mailbox setup is a simple steel mailbox mounted on a four by four pressure treated wooden post.

It should be 48 inches high from the road surface to the lowest horizontal plane of the assembly, and placed so no portion of the assembly is closer than 6 feet to the paved portion of the road.

No Plastic of any kind including Rubbermaid mailboxes is recommended. Plastic gets brittle in the cold weather and cannot withstand the snow being cast off the plow.

In the fall please check your mailbox and post for stability and any rotting or decay. Make sure it is secure and if not repair it before the snow removal season starts.

If you have a decorative mailbox please consider removing it before the snow removal season starts and replacing it with a standard metal mailbox for the duration of the season.

Please keep in mind that a home/property owner has no legal right to place a mailbox within the highway right of way. Mailboxes are only there as a convenience and courtesy for mail service.
